JOB DESCRIPTION

The Lifeguard shall be directly responsible to the Head Lifeguard and to the Executive Director.

Lifeguards shall be at least 17 years of age upon accepting this position, and shall be the holder of a current valid Lifeguard certificate as required by the Provincial Health and Protection and promotion Act. The Lifeguard shall have all relevant qualifications on hand at the pool for inspection by Health Officials on demand.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Participates in all training and orientation events provided by Edgewood, as well as other training seen as necessary or beneficial by Edgewood.
2. Assists with supervision and maintenance of all canoe equipment including canoes, safety equipment, paddles and First Aid equipment, and reports any breakage, damage, or malfunction to the Head Lifeguard.
3. Supervises, as assigned, all summer staff and campers while in the pool or pond areas.
4. Assists Head Lifeguard in maintaining pool water quality, showers and washrooms, and

deck around, in line with the Provincial Health Regulation and WHMIS legislation.

5. Assists with night time supervision.
6. Assists the Head Lifeguard in, assigned duties.
7. Assists with the Sunday registration process, as assigned.
8. Maintains an involvement in all camp activities (including meals, worship, campfires, cookouts, etc.)
8. Reports all injuries to the Camp Nurse and Head Lifeguard, complete with a written Incident Report.
9. Submits, in writing, a summer-end report/evaluation of the pool and canoe programmes, to the Head Lifeguard, for submission in the summer-end Lifeguards report prior to moving off site.

About Edgewood: Camp Edgewood is located just outside of Guelph, Ontario in a town called Eden Mills. It has offered over 60 summers of fun and memories to last a lifetime. Edgewood runs programs such as a day camp, one-week overnight camp, a teen camp, and the counsellor-in-training program. Summer Camp runs from mid-June until the end of August.
